Fever free for 24 hours WITHOUT the use of fever reducing medication i.e. Tylenol, Motrin, Advil	Free from vomiting for at least 2 solid meals or 24 hours without medication.	Free from diarrhea for at least 24 hours.	Free from rash, itching, or fever. I have been evaluated by a doctor if needed.	Treated with appropriate lice treatment at home and proof is provided to nurse.	Evaluated by my doctor and have a note to return to school.	Released by my medical provider to return to school.
