

BY-LAWS FOR BROOKWOOD HIGH SCHOOL GAMER'S CLUB

I. OFFICIAL NAME

The official name of this organization shall be the BHS GAMER'S CLUB

II. PURPOSE

- To promote a love of games of all types and provide a place for everyone to interact in an informal setting while enjoying a little friendly competition.
- Furthermore, we seek to teach others new games and encourage them to meet new people.

III. MEMBERSHIP

Qualification of Membership:

The club has an open membership policy to any interested students and staff at BHS.

Financial Obligations of Members:

It is encouraged that members pay \$40 a year or \$5 a month. This helps to pay for food, new games, tournaments, and other fun events we try to put on each semester. The dues however are not required to come to meetings and enjoy playing games.

IV. OFFICERS

The Gamer's Club has two official positions: President and Vice President. Their duties are as listed below:

- President

As president you head meetings and are primarily responsible for all of the clubs functions and coordinating all activities. The President must be informed on all aspects of the club and conduct relations between other officers and the club sponsor. Other duties include: drafting a club calendar, community outreach to encourage more members to attend the meetings.

- Vice President

This officer will be in charge of attending meetings, particularly those that the President is unable to attend. Also, the Vice President will help plan events and oversee the collaboration of others in the club as well as the President. This officer will also be in charge of maintaining a relationship with other clubs and helping the President to establish these relationships with outside organizations.

V. ELECTION PROCEDURES

Elections

- Standard elections are held in the Spring semester of each school year during the second-to-last meeting of the year. All members present at an election will have an equal secret vote. If a tie occurs, the President, if a senior, has the deciding vote. In the event of a tie in a vote involving the current President or Vice President, then all candidates are given an opportunity to sway voters one last time with their platform/ways they will seek to improve the club, and then a revote shall occur. If the revote shall result in a tie, then a final decision shall be made in true Gamer's fashion: the tie shall be broken by the role of a dodecahedron, even for one candidate, and odd for another.

VI. MEETINGS

- The club will hold general meetings on Fridays from 2:15 pm - 3:45 pm, barring any official holidays.
- The officers will meet a minimum of once a month, typically the morning of the first Friday of the month in the sponsor's classroom. Any successive officer meetings can be called by either the sponsor or the President.

VII. AMENDMENTS TO BY-LAWS

These By-Laws may be amended with the changing needs of the club. The Officers in conjunction with the sponsor will be responsible for any amendments.
