Dear student and family,

If you are receiving this letter, your student may be eligible to participate in the Duluth High School 2023 Summer Program *free of charge*. Our records indicate you/your student has failed OR is in danger of failing one of the courses needed for graduation. **\*\*\*If this is incorrect and you have passed your classes, please disregard this letter.\*\*\***

Beginning on **June 12, 2023**, and ending on **July 6, 2023**, Duluth High School will offer a Summer Program with the courses listed below. **To be eligible, a student must have previously failed the course.** The classes will be either an Online Hybrid model with students working in content rooms with a content teacher (for example, Science Room, Math Room, etc.) or some select Face to Face traditional classes. *(The ONLY Face to Face classes are: Algebra 1 Semester 1 & 2 AND Geometry Semester 2).* There is NO CHARGE for these classes. Upperclassmen are given priority.

**Registration closes May 26, 2023 at 2:00 pm and is subject to counselor approval.**

Important information:

- Classes are Monday – Friday, June 12 - July 6, 2023
- 1<sup>st</sup> session (AM) 7 :00 – 11:00 am, 2<sup>nd</sup> session (PM) 11:30 am – 3:30 pm
- Meals: Free breakfast is provided and lunch is available for purchase.
- No school June 19 and July 4, 2023
- Final exams: July 6, 2023; 1<sup>st</sup> session exam 7 – 9 am (break 9 – 9:15 am), 2<sup>nd</sup> session exam 9:15 – 11:15 am
- July 7, 2023: Graduation for all of GCPS Summer School, Gas South Arena, 10 am
- Attendance is mandatory for all Face to Face and OnlineHybrid classes: Students missing more than one day will be removed. All excused and unexcused absences count.
  - o Tardies: 3 tardies = 1 absence
  - o Late to class (more than 30 minutes) = 1 absence
  - o 2<sup>nd</sup> absence = withdrawal from program

There is no transportation provided. Students must provide their own.

## 2023 Summer School Class Offerings

1. Classes are offered in an Online Hybrid format meaning students work through online modules and are placed in a room with a content teacher. For example, all Science courses (Chemistry, Physics, etc.) will be in the Science Room with a Science teacher.
2. There are THREE Face to Face classes. These classes are offered in THIS FORMAT ONLY. There are no Online Hybrid classes offered for these courses.
3. Upperclassmen get priority. Students must have failed the course to be eligible.
