## Where to Find eCLASS Resources

### Resources for Students

#### MYeCLASS

The MYeCLASS Student Portal provides students with access to a number of resources, including:

- **MYeCLASS C&I Course Pages** that extend class online with information about assignments, a place for discussions, and other resources to help students. Students also can communicate with their teachers directly through the course pages.
- **Digital Textbooks** that correspond to the individual student's class schedule. (Not all textbooks are available on the portal at this time.)
- A **Media Catalog** specific to each school that includes Top 10 Books, Resource Lists, and New Arrivals.
- An **Online Research Library** that includes general reference materials, eBooks, and databases full of learning resources that are organized by school level (elementary, middle, and high school).
- **Additional digital resources**, such as links to websites (for example, Classworks, GSuite for Education, and SAFARI) that support what students are learning.
- **Grades for classes in student's current class schedule**, plus drill-down specifics on assignments.

All MYeCLASS resources are available with a single sign-on. Students log into MYeCLASS using their GCPS student number and the password they create at the beginning of the school year.

(If a student doesn't remember his or her password or does not have one, he or she should ask the teacher for help.)



#### Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)

Through our eCLASS initiative, all Gwinnett schools have received a wireless internet upgrade to support local school BYOD initiatives. Instructional activities can be enhanced when students bring their own personal devices (cell phones, tablets, laptops, eReaders, etc.) to class. GCPS encourages students to take advantage of the school system's BYOD policy, **but participation is not required.**

Ask your child's teacher about use of personal devices in class or go to the school system's website for more about BYOD in GCPS.



### Resources for Parents

#### Parent Portal



We know that families want easy access and one go-to location for need-to-know information about their student's education—from records to resources. On the Portal, you can:

- Look up **school holidays and events, even assignment due dates!** And, check your student's **schedule** to find course titles, teacher names, and room assignments.
- Check **grades and assignment scores** and learn about missing assignments.
- View **final grades for all grade levels**, and use easy-to-read graphics to **track progress toward graduation** for high school students.
- Opt in to get **email notifications** about school events, attendance, discipline incidents, and when a student performs below a specified grade.

- Easily update student information, including **emergency contact, phone numbers, and medical information.**
- See **attendance and discipline records, clinic visits, transcripts, graduation status, and more.**
- Get **language support**, with translation available in Spanish, Korean, Vietnamese, Chinese, and French.
