



Get Ready for Kindergarten.

Online Kindergarten Registration is now open!

Students who will attend kindergarten in Fall 2020 must submit two state forms as part of the school registration process—the form that shows evidence of vision, hearing, dental, and nutrition screenings in the past year (a current Georgia Form #3300, revised 2013) and a valid Certificate of Immunization (Georgia Form #3231). Your healthcare provider or dentist may complete these forms or you may visit one of the local health department locations to complete the forms.

Families that are unable to obtain the required immunization and/or screening documents due to the COVID-19 situation will be given additional time to obtain those documents but should go ahead and begin the online registration process.

Much of the registration process, including the [uploading of documents needed for registration](#), will be completed online. Most document attachments (PDF, JPG, DOC, PNG, etc.) are compatible. The file-size limit is 2 MB.

School screenings are provided as a walk-in service at the Gwinnett County health centers located in Buford, Lawrenceville, and Norcross. Families should arrive at least one hour before a center closes to make sure they have enough time to complete paperwork.
