Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. # Long Term Goal

All Coleman Middle School students will score in the proficient or distinguished range on all Georgia Milestones assessments by Spring 2026.

#### o Annual Goal

Coleman Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in Language Arts on the Georgia Milestones Assessment AND GCPS District Assessment Post-tests for English/Language Arts with 75% of all students in grade 6 - 8 scoring in proficient and distinguished performance levels with at least 25% scoring in the distinguished category

Coleman Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in Social Studies on the Georgia Milestones Assessment AND GCPS District Assessment Post-tests for Social Studies with: 75% of all students in grade 8 scoring in proficient and distinguished performance levels with at least 25% scoring in the distinguished category.

# o Annual Goal

Coleman Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in Mathematics on the Georgia Milestones Assessment AND GCPS District Assessment Post-tests for Mathematics with 75% of all students in grades 6-8 scoring in proficient and distinguished performance levels with at least 30% scoring in the distinguished category.

#### o Annual Goal

Coleman Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in Science on the Georgia Milestones Assessment AND GCPS District Assessment Post-tests for Science with 75% of all students in grade 8 scoring in proficient and distinguished performance levels with at least 35% scoring in the distinguished category.

Coleman Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in Science on GCPS District Assessment Post-tests for Science with 75% of all students in grades 6 and 7 scoring in proficient and distinguished performance levels with at least 35% scoring in the distinguished category.

### Long Term Goal

All Coleman Middle School students will meet typical or high growth as measured in the progress section of the College and Career Readiness Performance Index by Spring 2026.

#### o Annual Goal

100% of Coleman Middle School students will score 70% or higher on teacher generated final exam assessments in all connection classes.

#### o Annual Goal

Coleman Middle School will commit to maintaining its positive school climate by, in part, striving for at least 90% of students earning 0 discipline referrals during the 2021-2022 school year.
