Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. • Long Term Goal

Creekland Middle School will increase the percentage of students scoring in the “Proficient Learners” or “Distinguished Learners” range on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for English/language arts and mathematics to 100% in 2021-2022.

o Annual Goal

Creekland Middle school students will demonstrate mastery on the Georgia Milestones in Language Arts scoring in the proficient and distinguished performance levels as follows:

6th: 64% or better in p/d

7th: 56% or better in p/d

8th: 66% or better in p/d

Departmental Goals: Creekland Middle school students will demonstrate mastery on the 1st semester final exams in Language Arts scoring in the proficient and distinguished performance as follows:

6th: 64% or better in p/d

7th: 56% or better in p/d

8th: 66% or better in p/d

All gifted/blended courses students are to be 100% proficient/distinguished (15% or less proficient) (85% or better distinguished).

o Annual Goal

Creekland Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in math with students scoring in the proficient or distinguished levels on the Georgia Milestones assessments.

6th: 62% or better in P/D (standard) --- 6th accelerated 85% or better (P/D)

7th: 66% or better in P/D (standard) --- 7th accelerated 85% or better (P/D)

8th: 69% or better in P/D (standard) --- Algebra I 69% or better (P/D) --- Accelerated Algebra I 95% or better in P/D

All gifted/blended courses students are to be 100% proficient/distinguished (15% or less proficient) (85% or better distinguished).

Departmental Goal: Creekland Middle School students will demonstrate mastery on 1st semester final exams by moving more students into the proficient and distinguished levels.

6th: 62% or better in P/D (standard) --- 6th accelerated 85% or better (P/D)

7th: 66% or better in P/D (standard) --- 7th accelerated 85% or better (P/D)

8th: 69% or better in P/D (standard) --- Algebra I 69% or better (P/D) --- Accelerated Algebra I 95% or better in P/D.

All gifted/blended courses students are to be 100% proficient/distinguished (15% or less proficient) (85% or better distinguished).



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• Long Term Goal

Creekland Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in mathematics with 100% of students scoring in the "Proficient Learners" or "Distinguished Learners" range on the Algebra I End of Course State Assessment in 2021-2022 and mastery in physical science with 100% of students scoring in the "Proficient" or "Distinguished" range on the Physical Science State Assessment in 2021-2022.

o Annual Goal

Creekland Middle school students will demonstrate mastery on the Georgia Milestones in Social Studies scoring in the proficient and distinguished performance levels

as follows:

65% or better in p/d

Departmental Goal: Creekland Middle school students will demonstrate mastery on the first semester final exam scoring in the proficient and distinguished performance levels

as follows:

6th grade: 62% or better in p/d

7th grade: 62% or better in p/d

8th grade: 65% or better in p/d

All gifted/blended courses students are to be 100% proficient/distinguished (15% or less proficient) (85% or better distinguished).

• Long Term Goal

Creekland Middle School will increase the percentage of students scoring in the "Proficient Learners" or "Distinguished Learners" range on the district assessments for English/language arts, science, social studies and mathematics to 100% by the 2021-2022 school year.

o Annual Goal

Creekland Middle school students will demonstrate mastery on the Georgia Milestones in Physical Science scoring in the proficient and distinguished performance levels

as follows:

65% or better in p/d

Departmental Goal: Creekland Middle school students will demonstrate mastery on the first semester final exam scoring in the proficient and distinguished performance levels

as follows:

6th (Earth): 65%; or better in p/d

7th (Life): 65% or better in p/d

8th (Physical): 65% or better in p/d

All gifted/blended courses students are to be 100% proficient/distinguished (15% or less proficient) (85% or better distinguished).
