Local School Plan for Improvement

Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. • Long Term Goal

One hundred percent of Crews Middle School students will achieve Proficient Distinguished in English language arts, mathematics, and high school physical science objectives as measured by state assessments by Spring 2025.

o Annual Goal

Crews Middle School will, by the end of the 2021-2022 school year, increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished performance levels in Language Arts on the End of Grade assessment to at least 80% in 6th grade, 75% in 7th grade, and 85% in 8th grade. Additionally, 35% of students will score at the distinguished performance level English/Language Arts for all grade levels.

o Annual Goal

Crews Middle School will, by the end of the 2021-2022 school year, increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished performance levels in Mathematics on the End of Grade assessment to 85% in 6th grade and 85% in 7th grade. In 8th grade, the combined percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished categories on the End of Grade Math and End of Course Algebra assessments will be 80%. Additionally, the percentage of students performing at the Distinguished level will increase to 35% on those same assessments.

o Annual Goal

Crews Middle School will, by the end of the 2021-2022 school year, increase the combined percentage scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished categories in Physical Science on the End of Course assessment to 80%. The percent of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished categories in Biology on the End of Course assessment will be 100% with 85% scoring in the Distinguished level.

o Annual Goal

The percent of 8th grade social studies students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished categories on the End of Grade assessment will increase to 80%. Additionally, the percentage of students scoring at the distinguished performance level will increase 50% on the Georgia Milestones Assessments for Science and Social Studies.

• Long Term Goal

One hundred percent of Crews Middle School students will meet typical or high growth as measured in the Progress section of the College and Career Readiness Performance Index by Spring 2025.

o Annual Goal

All Crews Middle School students will score 75% or higher on all locally created common assessments in connections, science, and social studies for the 2021-2022 school year.

o Annual Goal

100% of students at Crews Middle School will participate in a club, athletic team, fine arts program, or other activity that connects them to school outside of academics. Our Connected at Crews initiative aims to build and improve the engagement and connectedness of our students.
