Local School Plan for Improvement

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

GIVE Center East will increase the number of students that score at the proficient or distinguished level on local school, district, and state language arts, science, social studies, and math assessments by 5% in 2021-22, 10% in 2022-23, and 15% in 2023-24.

- o **Annual Goal**

GIVE Center East students will demonstrate mastery in Language Arts, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies with 50% of all students scoring at the Proficient or Distinguished performance level on all District Assessments.

- **Long Term Goal**

GIVE Center East will increase the number of students that regain “on-track” academic standings with their graduation cohort by 10% in 2021-22, 15% in 2022-23, and 20% in 2023-24.

- o **Annual Goal**

As a measure to increase students' cohort graduation rate, GIVE Center East will increase the percent of full-time students in grades 6-8 that earn 70% or higher in all core academic classes, and grades 9-12 that earn an average of 3.0 credits per semester by 10% in 2021-2022.

- **Long Term Goal**

GIVE Center East will decrease the number of total Out-of-School suspension days by 10% in 2021-22, 15% in 2022-23, and 20% in 2023-24.

- o **Annual Goal**

GIVE Center East will decrease the amount of time spent away from instruction due to behavior (as measured by the number of In-School Suspension and Out-of-School Suspension days) by 10% in 2021-22.

- **Long Term Goal**

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in The Plan/The Promise.
