Local School Plan for Improvement

Gwinnett Online Campus School

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Gwinnett Online Campus will increase the percentage of students scoring at the “proficient” or “distinguished” level on the Georgia Milestones EOG and EOC Assessments for English/Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science to 100 % by 2023 with at least 25% scoring at the “distinguished” level.

- o **Annual Goal**

Gwinnett Online Campus will serve full-time students in grades 4 - 12 and GCPS digital students in grades 6 - 12. The goal will be for all students to complete their courses with a final average of 70% or higher with an overall pass rate of at least 90% for each course.

- **Long Term Goal**

Gwinnett Online Campus will rank among the top 5 schools in the district at the middle, and high school level on the Georgia Milestones EOG and EOC Assessments.

- **Long Term Goal**

Gwinnett Online Campus (GOC) will continue to be an international leader in online/blended delivery systems. GOC will leverage this expertise to form partnerships with internationally recognized education companies to design and implement an adaptive learning environment. GOC will continue to develop innovative models of instruction to support schools and programs across the district.

- o **Annual Goal**

Gwinnett Online Campus has developed a Personalized Learning (PL) Framework in collaboration with D2L to provide an adaptive personalized learning experience. GOC will continue collecting data on student success making adjustments to the 10 current PL courses based on the data analysis. In addition, new PL courses will continue to be developed during the 2021-2022 school year.

- o **Annual Goal**

Gwinnett Online Campus will continue expanding and improving specific programs and online delivery models to support the needs of students across the district.

- **Long Term Goal**

Gwinnett Online Campus will increase the four-year cohort graduation rate to at least 67% by 2023.

- o **Annual Goal**

Gwinnett Online Campus will raise the graduation cohort rate by at least 5% for the 2021-2022 school year.
