## Local School Plan for Improvement

Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in The Plan/The Promise.

- **Long Term Goal**

By 2026, 85% of Jackson Elementary School students will score in the Proficient and Distinguished Learner performance levels with 40% scoring in the Distinguished Learner performance level on the Georgia Milestones End of Grade Assessment in English/Language Arts.

- **Annual Goal**

Jackson Elementary School staff will increase the percentage of students in grades 3, 4, and 5 achieving in the Proficient and Distinguished Learner performance levels on the Georgia Milestones English Language Arts content assessment by 7-10% points over the 2020-21 Georgia Milestones Results in English Language Arts. 85% of students in grades K, 1, and 2 will be on or above the Independent Reading Level Expectation for their grade level based on the F&P Benchmark Assessment System.

- **Annual Goal**

65% of students in grades 3, 4, and 5 will score at the Proficient and Distinguished levels on the Social Studies Post Test District Assessment.

- **Long Term Goal**

By 2026, 90% of Jackson Elementary School students will score in the Proficient and Distinguished Learner performance levels with 45% scoring in the Distinguished Learner performance level on the Georgia Milestones End of Grade Assessment in Math.

- **Annual Goal**

Jackson Elementary School staff will increase the percentage of students in grades 3, 4, and 5 achieving at the Proficient and Distinguished Learner performance levels on the Georgia Milestones Math content assessment by 7-10% points over the 2018-19 Georgia Milestones Results in Math. 85% of students in grades K, 1, and 2 will score at the Proficient and Distinguished levels on the Math Post District Assessment.

- **Long Term Goal**

By 2026, 85% of Jackson Elementary School fifth grade students will score in the Proficient and Distinguished Learner performance levels with 45% scoring in the Distinguished Learner performance level on the Georgia Milestones End of Grade Assessment in Science.

- **Annual Goal**

Jackson Elementary School staff will increase the percentage of students in grade 5 achieving at the Proficient and Distinguished Learner performance levels on the Georgia Milestones Science content assessment by 7-10% points over the 2021-22 Georgia Milestones Results in Science. 65% of students in grades 3, 4, and 5 will score at the Proficient and Distinguished levels on the Science Post Test District Assessment.
