Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. • Long Term Goal

By 2025, 75% of NMAPA students will score in the Proficient and Distinguished Learner performance levels with 35% scoring in the Distinguished Learner performance level on the Georgia Milestones End of Grade Assessment in Math.

o Annual Goal

NMAPA staff will increase the percentage of students in grades 3, 4, and 5 achieving at the Proficient and Distinguished Learner performance levels on the Georgia Milestones Math content assessment by 7-30% points over the 2020-21 Georgia Milestones Results in Math; 100% of our K-2 students will perform at 70% or above on the end of the year District Assessment.

• Long Term Goal

By 2025, 75% of North Metro Academy of Performing Arts (NMAPA) students will score in the Proficient and Distinguished Learner performance levels with 35% scoring in the Distinguished Learner performance level on the Georgia Milestones End of Grade Assessment in English/Language Arts.

o Annual Goal

NMAPA staff will increase the percentage of students in grades 3, 4, and 5 achieving in the Proficient and Distinguished Learner performance levels on the Georgia Milestones English Language Arts content assessment by 7-30% points over the 2020-2021 Georgia Milestones Results in English Language Arts; 100% of our K-2 students will perform at 70% or above on the end of the year District Assessment.

o Annual Goal

NMAPA staff will increase the percentage of students in grade 5 achieving at the Proficient and Distinguished Learner performance levels on the GCPS District Social Studies Assessment by 10% points over the 2020-2021 District Assessment.

• Long Term Goal

By 2025, 75% of North Metro Academy of Performing Arts (NMAPA) 5th-grade students will score in the Proficient and Distinguished Learner performance levels with 35% scoring in the Distinguished Learner performance level on the Georgia Milestones End of Grade Assessment in Science.

o Annual Goal

NMAPA staff will increase the percentage of students in grade 5 achieving at the Proficient and Distinguished Learner performance levels on the Georgia Milestones Science content assessment by 15% points over the 2020-21 Georgia Milestones Results in Science, and students will score 100% in the Proficient & Distinguished range for Science.

• Long Term Goal

By 2025, North Metro Academy of the Performing Arts students will engage in 4-6 yearly authentic emersion/exploration opportunities within the fine arts (theatre, visual, music, and dance).



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o Annual Goal

North Metro Academy of the Performing Arts students will engage in 2-3 authentic emersion/exploration opportunities within the fine arts (theatre, visual arts, music, and dance) during the 2021-2022 school year.
