The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. LSPI ELA Goal: During the 2021-2022 school year, K-5 students will demonstrate an increase in their reading comprehension, reading fluency, and writing performance.

80% (or more) of students in K-5 will score Proficient or Distinguished on the ELA District Assessments. 25% (or more) of students will score Distinguished on the ELA District Assessments.

80% (or more) of students in 3-5 will score Proficient or Distinguished on the ELA Georgia Milestones Assessment System.

25% (or more) of students will score Distinguished on the Georgia Milestones Assessment System.

Parsons Elementary School will continue to increase the number of students, in grades 3-5, who will perform in the Proficient and Distinguished Learners range on the Mathematics subtest of the Georgia Milestones Assessment System. 85% of students in grades 3-5 will score in the Proficient and Distinguished range on the Spring 2023 Georgia Milestones Assessment System. 25% of students in grades 3-5 will perform in the Distinguished range on the Spring 2023 Georgia Milestones Assessment System.

LSPI Math Goal: During the 2021-2022 school year, K-5 students will demonstrate an increase in their math computation and mastery of mathematical concepts.

80% (or more) of students in K-5 will score Proficient or Distinguished on the Math District Assessments. 25% (or more) of students will score Distinguished on the Math District Assessments.

80% (or more) of students in 3-5 will score Proficient or Distinguished on the Math Georgia Milestones Assessment System.

25% (or more) of students will score Distinguished on the Georgia Milestones Assessment System.
