Local School Plan for Improvement

South Gwinnett High School

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

The Academy at South Gwinnett High School will increase its Meets and Exceeds rates annually for ALL students on the Language Arts/Social Studies and Language Arts/Science sections of the Gateway Exam.

- o **Annual Goal**

SGHS will achieve a Meets and Exceeds rate of 81% (LA/SC) and 80% (LA/SS) on the Gateway Exam during the 2021-2022 school year.

- **Long Term Goal**

The Academy at South Gwinnett High School will increase its cohort graduation rate for all future graduating classes.

- o **Annual Goal**

SGHS will increase its 4-year cohort graduation rate to 90% for the 2021-2022 school year.

- **Long Term Goal**

The Academy at South Gwinnett High School will increase its success/achievement rate annually on the English/Language Arts, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies sections of the Georgia Milestones Assessment System. Additionally, SGHS will demonstrate increased achievement on other local, state, national, and international exams for ALL students.

- o **Annual Goal**

SGHS will exceed 2020-2021 enrollment for AP courses in the 2021-2022 school year. SGHS also will increase the number of students who take AP assessments and student achievement on AP assessments.

- **Long Term Goal**

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in The Plan/The Promise.
