Summer Learning Support • Enrichment • Achievement (SEA) program

This **free** summer program will offer extended learning opportunities to support the grade-level readiness of students who need to meet promotional criteria through an engaging learning environment.

Elementary school students will attend the **free Summer Learning SEA program** from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. and middle school students will attend from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. during the three-week session (June 12–June 30). In **Rising K Academy**, new kindergartners will meet new friends, learn through play, and practice skills they will need to be ready for school in the fall. The **free**, in-person program will run June 12–June 30, 8 a.m. to 2 p.m., with a holiday on June 19. Families must complete online kindergarten registration by May 19 for their child to participate in Rising K Academy.

Transportation and meals (breakfast and lunch) are provided for children participating in the SEA program and in Rising K Academy at no cost to families.





FAQS

What is the SEA program?

The SEA program provides extended learning opportunities to support the grade-level readiness of students who need to meet promotional requirements through an engaging learning environment that includes hands-on experimental enrichment activities. Students will work in flexible learning groups and teachers will share information in new ways to help your child meet promotion criteria. In addition, all students in SEA will participate in enrichment activities. Fun and engaging learning opportunities will cover subject areas typically offered in Specials and Connections courses.

Who can attend the SEA program?

Schools have selected students who are not meeting promotion requirements to participate in the program.

What are the dates and hours for SEA?

During the three-week session, (June 12–June 30), students will attend Monday through Friday. June 19 is a school holiday. Elementary students will attend the free SEA Program from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. and middle school students will attend the program from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

How much does it cost to attend?

This three-week program is free to attend. Meals (breakfast and lunch) and transportation are provided at no cost to families.

How do I register my child for this program?

Your child's school will send a registration link to your portal account inviting your child to participate in SEA. Please complete this online form by the deadline to reserve your child's place in the program. If you do not complete the registration by the deadline, your child will not be able to attend.

My child did not meet promotion requirements and has been recommended for SEA. Is participation required for promotion?

Participation is required in order to give your child support to meet promotion requirements.

When is the last day to register?

The last day to register is May 5.

What if my child meets promotion criteria at the end of the year?

If you have registered your student they are welcome to attend.

If my child can't attend or was not invited to attend, are there other options for summer learning?

Yes. Students in grades K–8 can access the Digital Summer Support eCLASS page to participate in self-paced, online summer support opportunities in reading and math from June 5–July 7.
