Inroads Scholarship

\$1000-\$2500

- 3.0+ GPA
- Latinx students

Golden Door Scholarship

Funding for a four-year degree program*

- Specifically for students with DACA, TPS, or who are Undocumented
- Must be willing to explore and apply for other scholarships in addition to Golden Door
- Applicants should have strong academic records

*at a Golden Door partner college - other schools will be considered

Dr. Juan Andrade JR. Scholarship for Young Hispanic Leaders

\$1000 for four-year institution OR \$500 for two-year institution

- At least one parent must be of Hispanic ancestry.
- Non-U.S. citizens are eligible to apply (DACA or Undocumented).
- Applicants must be full-time undergraduate students for the Fall 2022 – Spring 2023 academic year. This includes high school seniors, college freshman, sophomores, and juniors up to age 25.
- Essays, Letters of Recommendation, and other requirements listed on website

Hispanic Heritage Foundation Youth Awards

One-time grant to fund college education

- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must be enrolled at college/university for 2022-2026 school year
- Must be of Hispanic heritage (includes Spain, Brazil, Philippines)
- Must be US permanent resident, US citizen, or DACA

McDonald's HACER National Scholarship

Up to \$100,000

- For current high school seniors
- Legal US Resident
- Minimum 2.8 GPA
- Will attend college/university full time for 2022-2023 school year
- At least one parent of Hispanic heritage

Hispanic Scholarship Fund

\$500 to \$5,000

- Hispanic heritage
- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Plan to enroll full-time in an accredited, not-for-profit, four-year university 2022-2023
- US Citizen, Permanent Legal Resident, DACA, or Eligible Non-Citizen (as defined by FAFSA)
- Complete FAFSA or state based financial aid application

Dream.US Opportunity Scholarship

Up to \$80,000 (\$20k max/yr for 4 years) // Deadline details coming soon

- Specifically for students with DACA, TPS, or who are Undocumented
- Must have significant unmet financial need
- 2.8+ GPA
- Must have taken the SAT or ACT
- Intend to relocate to and enroll full-time in a bachelor's program at a partner college

Alcanzando Un Sueño \$3000

- At least one parent of Hispanic descent
- At least 3.0 min GPA
- Must graduate in the spring of the application year
- Must be accepted in an accredited post-secondary institution
- Open to all students regardless of immigration status

Goizueta Scholars Georgia Southern

- Latino/Hispanic students interested in becoming teachers
- Students will need to complete their Georgia Southern admissions application in advance of that date and be accepted to have access to the scholarship application.
