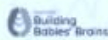


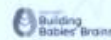

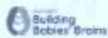

The Gwinnett County Board of Education has proclaimed today, September 25, 2020, as Building Babies' Brains Day in Gwinnett County Public Schools! Only 48% of children in our community start school prepared to learn. Early brain development is a key factor in making sure children in Gwinnett County are ready to thrive in kindergarten and beyond!

Children exposed to positive early learning experiences—like reading, singing, and talking with caregivers—are less likely to have academic and behavioral problems in school. They are more likely to be strong readers by 3rd grade and graduate from high school.
