- GCPS Student - Retaking a Previously failed course: FREE
- GCPS Student - Credit Recovery: \$100 for each class
- GCPS Student - Summer School, first time taking the course: \$250.00 for each class
- Non-GCPS Student - Summer School: \$275.00 for each class

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Gwinnett Online Campus offers online summer school for students in grades 9-12. Students can take courses to get ahead or to make-up a class they previously failed. **All courses require an in-person final exam or EOC at our GOC location, 713 Hi Hope Road, Lawrenceville, GA 30043.**
- Gwinnett County Public Schools will pay for up to two summer school classes for high school students needing to retake a class they previously failed. The district is offering this option to students at no cost to address COVID-related learning gaps and to provide students with an additional opportunity to earn credit for courses failed this year.
- ***Students who are taking a course at no cost and who do not log in within the first two days of class will be automatically dropped.**
- Students who wish to take courses to get ahead, or take more than 2 classes this summer, may register through our tuition-based option. Course fees are \$250 per 0.5 credit. Non-GCPS students pay \$275 per course.

Registrations close the Thursday prior to start date

Session 1	5/31 - 6/3	9 AM - 11 AM
Session 2	6/6-7 & 6/13-14 (Four days split over 2 weeks)	9 AM - 11 AM
Session 3	7/18 - 21 (**Not available for future Seckinger students**)	9 AM - 11 AM
Session 4	7/25 - 27 (3 in person days only - course must be done by 29 th) **Not Available to future Seckinger students**	2:30 - 4:30

Credit Recovery Dates: Students must attend all days during their session **until they finish the course.** Once they have finished, they do not have to attend. Students may work on their course anytime outside of the session but must be present during their session’s times. This means they can work on it at home and anytime it is convenient. Additionally, courses must be completed by the last day of the session, or the student will be withdrawn without credit. ****Important note:** Students are only allowed one attempt on the final exam and must complete it once they open it - I can not reopen it. This is different from module post tests, which can be taken as many times as needed to get a 70%**
