## **Gwinnett County Public School System's Parent Mentors Serving Families of Students Who Receive Special Education Services**

Gwinnett County Public Schools (GCPS) Parent Mentors help provide parents of students who receive special education services in GCPS information, guidance, and resources to help support their children at home, school and in their communities.

GCPS parent mentors have or have had a child who receive special education services in the district and can relate to the challenges of raising a child who is differently challenged. We work within the school district to teach and guide families in a variety of ways. We can provide support and information regarding transition planning, parent support groups, Social Security Income, Medicaid, other disability funding, agencies that support individuals with disabilities, recreation, community resources, and other information related to disabilities.

We collaborate with school administrators and teachers, supporting educators in their efforts to help families and students plan for and achieve their educational and post-secondary goals.

Due to the pandemic, the monthly informational meetings and other in-person workshops we have offered parents during past school years are not currently scheduled. However, as opportunities arise during the school year, we will share information through GCPS's website and through our local schools.
