

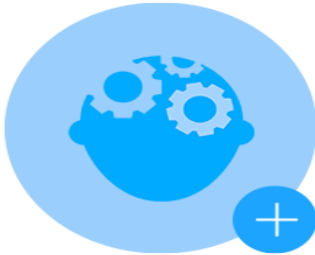


Mustang Mastery Intervention Program (MMIP)

What is MMIP?

Lilburn Middle School is excited to have the opportunity to provide interventions for our scholars who have excessive NTI's, gifted learners, and students who struggle to demonstrate mastery. Scholars with different learning needs require different intervention approaches, so this intervention program will be targeted to support the needs of individual learners at Lilburn Middle School. **The Mustang Mastery Intervention Programs** are listed below.

Mustang Mastery Math/ELA Remediation and Academic Intervention (Dates: October 31, November 7th and November 14th)



Scholars who require skill development in the areas of ELA and MA require direct instruction in the areas of their skill deficit. Scholars are provided support to recover failing grades due to underachievement on assignments.

Mustang Mastery Academic Assistance/Grade Recovery (Dates: December 5th and December 12th)



Learners who have excessive NTIs on major assignments that result in a negatively impacted grade. These scholars have demonstrated standard proficiency, but struggle with work completion. They can use this opportunity to obtain assistance in completing those outstanding assignments.

Mustang Mastery Math/ELA Gifted Extension (Dates: December 5th and December 12th)



Scholars who require skill development in the areas of ELA and MA require direct instruction in the areas of their skill deficit. Scholars are provided extra support for gifted students to meet distinguished performance levels.

Implementation: Intervention instructions can help struggling scholars demonstrate their basic skills. This extra support can help our scholars catch up to their peers. This program is designed to help close the gap between what a scholar knows and what the scholar is expected to understand. This program targets reading and math skills. **A new program that has been added this year is assisting parents in understanding how to help your children through technology. This is a 2 hour Academy for Parents session that is on December 5th from 10 am to 12 pm.**

Frequently Asked Questions

Who can benefit from MMIP? The most wonderful thing about MMIP is that it is truly for scholars who need that extra help! From children with academic delays to adults that acquired extra communication skills, MMIP is an option for both scholars and parents in some way, shape or form.

Will transportation be available? No, transportation is not provided. Scholars will need to arrive by 8:00 and someone will need to provide transportation home. Scholars should be picked up by 12:00 pm.

What time is MMIP? All classes will be held from 8:00 to 12:00 pm. Scholars must be dropped off by 8:00 am and must be picked up by 12:00 pm.

Will Breakfast and Lunch be provided? Yes, breakfast and lunch will be provided for **in person scholars only**.
