Summer School FAQs

What are the dates and times for summer school?

Dates: Monday, June 10th - Friday, June 28th

Hours: 7:30 a.m. - 2:30 p.m.

There are two different sessions 7:30 a.m. -10:45 p.m. or 11:15 a.m. -2:30 p.m.

Is it true that summer school will only be a 4 day week as it has been in the past?

No. Summer school will meet Monday - Friday.

I received a Summer School final notification stating that he/she must attend summer. What do I do next?

You must register your child onsite on **Friday, June 4th** in the Moore Middle School Media Center between **12:00PM and 3:30PM**. Students must be registered during the on-site registration in order to attend summer school. **Students not registered on June 4th will not be admitted to Summer School.**

Does my child have to attend all 15 days of summer school to receive credit?

Yes. Summer school is for promotion. Because summer school meets for only 3 weeks, every day of instruction is critical. Students must also be here on time or risk being dismissed from summer school thereby jeopardizing their promotion to the next grade level.

Can a student attend summer school for remediation (or extra help)?

No. Students who need summer school to earn promotion are invited to attend summer school.

Will my student participate in the lunch program?

Yes. Breakfast and lunch will be provided each day at no cost.

What is the dress code for summer school?

The dress code is the same as during the regular school year.

What supplies will my child need for summer school?

Each student will need to bring paper, pencils and pens for summer school. For the most part, all work will be completed at school. **No backpacks are allowed during summer school.**

When will I know if my child has passed?

Parents will receive progress reports from the teachers about the effort/grades of their students. A final progress report will be mailed following the last day of summer school, which indicates whether a student has shown improvement/mastery of the AKS to be promoted to the next grade level.

How will the GCPS/MMS Discipline policy be enforced?

The same rules of conduct that are enforced during the school year apply to summer school. Students who choose to misbehave can be dismissed from summer school.

What is the fee for summer school?

There is no charge for a student to attend summer school.

Does GCPS provide transportation?

No. Parents must provide transportation to and from summer school. It is imperative that reliable and timely transportation be provided by parents to and from school. Failure to arrive on time and/or to be picked up on time can result in dismissal from summer school.
