Q: What is KinderCAMP?

A: KinderCAMP is a one day camp where our newest MPES Cougars get to learn about their school, meet some of the teachers, test drive eating lunch in the cafeteria, go to specials and get an idea of what Kindergarten is all about.

Q: What supplies do I need to bring?

A: Comfortable clothes, tennis shoes, and lunch. Please apply sunscreen before you arrive because we will play on the playground if the weather is nice.

Q: What does arrival look like?

A: Bring your child to the cafeteria to check-in at 9:00am.

Q: What does dismissal look like?
