As we gear up for the SY19-20 school year, the Gwinnett County School Nutrition Program would like to thank you for your support and the opportunity to provide meals to your students. We have over 1,500 school nutrition professionals who strive to provide healthy and nutritious breakfast and lunch meals to all the students of Gwinnett County Public Schools.

The Gwinnett County School Nutrition Program is pleased to introduce a new breakfast program at your school.

Effective August 5, 2019, the Gwinnett County School Nutrition Program has made the decision that Universal Breakfast will be offered to designated GCPS Title 1 Middle Schools and High Schools. For SY19-20, your school has been designated a GCPS Title 1 school and therefore will now be eligible to offer Universal Breakfast. This means that all students will be able to receive breakfast at no cost.

However, there will be no changes to the lunch program at your school. All students will be required to pay for their lunch based on their current eligibility status. The lunch prices for SY19-20 are:

Free	No Charge
Reduced	\$.40 cents
Full Pay	\$2.50

You will still be able to add funds to your child's account just as you have always done by visiting <https://www.mypaymentsplus.com/welcome>. Please keep in mind that it can take up to 24 hours for funds to show up at the school level.
