

**Mill Creek Mu Alpha Theta Membership Information for New and Returning Members**  
2019-2020

Purpose: To promote scholarship in mathematics and service to the community. The Mill Creek chapter of Mu Alpha Theta is part of the National Math Honor Society.

Dues: \$25.00 per year due by September 30 for new members and \$20 for returning members. T-shirts are \$10 more (\$35 and \$30 with t-shirt).

Eligibility Requirements

~ **Grade Level** – Fifth semester or more of high school math, meaning pre-calculus and up.

~ **Grades** – The student must have a grade of at least 85 in each gifted or honors mathematics course and/or a grade of 90 in each academic college prep math course and be currently enrolled in or completed Pre-Calculus, Calculus AB, BC or AP Statistics. The student is responsible for verifying grades with a sponsor at the end of each semester. A copy of the report card may be used for this purpose. **SENIORS: YOU MUST BE EARNING AT LEAST AN 80 IN YOUR SECOND SEMESTER MATH CLASS AT CHORD DISTRIBUTION OR YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO RECEIVE ONE.**

~ **Service** – **All members:** At least Twenty hours with a minimum of 10 being in RISE. The other 10 may include other service hours or math tutoring outside of RISE. ALL 20 hours may be done in RISE. Each day in RISE counts as 1 hour.

**\* Seniors must complete all 10 intervention hours by December. All 20 hours must be due by the March meeting.**

**Underclassmen...all hours are due by the last meeting.**

~ **Attendance at meetings** – In order to maintain membership in Mu Alpha Theta, members may have no more than ONE unexcused absence per school year.

If you miss a meeting with an excused absence from the advisor...including conflicts with other meetings, sickness, sports practices, music rehearsal, etc....then you must serve one additional hour in RISE beyond the 20 required hours. (For example...you must have at least 11 Rise hours in addition to your other 10 hours if you miss a meeting and it is excused).

If you are absent from a meeting, you must e-mail me [sabrina\\_hancock@gwinnett.k12.ga.us](mailto:sabrina_hancock@gwinnett.k12.ga.us) with your excuse within 2 days; otherwise, it will be considered unexcused.

**Transportation: All students are responsible for their own transportation to and from meetings as well as all activities they choose as service opportunities.**
