### Each application must include:

- This form completed and signed by the student. Incomplete forms may be disqualified.
- Certified High School Transcript. It should include all academic credit towards a high school diploma through the first semester or quarter of the 12th grade, numeric GPA calculated for Georgia’s HOPE scholarship eligibility, highest SAT or ACT scores, High School Graduation Test scores (HSGTs), as well as identify the student’s diploma track (college preparatory or technology and career preparatory).
- Recommendation letter from a teacher under whom the student has studied during high school.
- Character reference letter from an adult who is not related to the student.
- Optional: Description of special circumstances about which the committee should be aware (e.g., siblings in college, financial need, etc.).

### Answer the following questions:

**(Not to exceed two (2) pages, 12 pt. Times New Roman font, double-spaced)**

- What is your proposed field of study and what are your goals in continuing your education?
- Why have you chosen this career field?
- How is it youth related? (Educational Scholarship applicants only)
- List primary activities in which you have participated (school, church, community) during high school. You may attach a resume as an additional page.
- List all colleges, universities or technical schools to which you have applied. Indicate the status of each application.

All scholarship checks will be mailed to the scholarship recipient after receipt by Georgia PTA of enrollment verification from the school or institution. The number and amount of each scholarship is determined by the donations given by the local PTA units and council.
