Why should I read over the summer?

Avoid the "summer slide" through the Osborne Summer Reading Challenge! [Research](#) suggests that students who read over the summer improve their reading skills, while students who do not read experience a decrease in achievement. The goal of the Osborne Summer Reading Challenge is to strengthen our students' reading skills using student choice of quality, engaging titles. Osborne Middle students are not required to participate in the Summer Reading Challenge; however, students who participate will have opportunities to earn prizes.

- Read at least three (3) books of your choice using the following guidelines:
 - Minimum of 150 pages
 - Fiction and/or nonfiction (no graphic novels).
- Complete the [Summer Reading Log](#).
- Win prizes!
 - Candy, bookmarks, pencils
 - Visit to the GCPS Book Mobile for free books
 - Chick-Fil-A gift cards
 - Grand prize: 1 Amazon Fire tablet per grade level
