To all Parents:

Based on DOE guidelines and GCPS best practices concerning bus stop locations, we are evaluating our existing bus stops and making changes to some bus stop locations. Several changes have already been implemented during the SY 18-19. You can check the Parent Portal at the end of July or check with your school @ Open House in August for bus stop updates.

Guidelines are as follows:

- Buses will only travel streets at least 3/10 of a mile and also provide a safe turnaround
- Bus stops will not be set closer than 1/10 of a mile apart (most GCPS students are not required to walk more than 3/10 of a mile)
- Stops will be located at least 1/10 of a mile from a high speed road (40+ mph)
- Same side stops will be provided for students living on roads that are 40+ mph
- Students are not permitted to cross multi-lane roads
- Stops will be set on a limited basis for high school students living less than 1½ miles from their home school based on Georgia Code 20-2-188
