Britt Elementary is offering a 6-week intramural program for 3rd and 4th Graders before school on Mondays from March 13-April 24, 2023. This program serves as an extension of the physical education program by providing students the opportunity to participate on an informal, voluntary basis. Activities may include individual and team sports, including gymnastics, basketball, volleyball, cup stacking, running, fitness, and/or soccer.

Students who wish to participate must have transportation provided to the school. The program will begin at 7:35 a.m. and conclude at 8:15 a.m. Students will go to their classrooms when the bell rings at 8:20 a.m. and be able to eat breakfast.

If you wish for your child to participate, the registration form must be turned in to Coach Robertson no later than March 8, 2023.

Program Dates:

The Intramural program will meet every Monday on the following dates from 7:35-8:15 a.m.:

- March 13, 20, 27
- April 10, 17, 24

Practices will be held outside on the Britt Elementary track/field and/or in the gym. Participants should bring their own water bottle and be dressed for running and other movement activities in appropriate clothes and tennis shoes.

The Following are Expectations for all Program Members:

- Exemplary Behavior during the school day and during club meetings
- Prompt Arrival and Dismissal
- Mandatory Attendance
- During club sessions, members are expected to give their best effort, work as a team, have a positive attitude, and hold up the highest standards of behavior.

****In the event that any of the expectations are not met, Coach Robertson has the authority to determine whether a student is able to continue participation in the Intramural program.***

Attendance Expectations:

Intramural program members are expected to attend EVERY meeting. A student may bring a note from a parent the day following a missed meeting (or the first day back from an illness) for an excused absence. A student may not simply tell me why he or she was absent. They must bring me a note written and signed by a parent. A student may have no more than 2 unexcused absences. Please make a note of this expectation. The program cannot be offered if students are not in attendance.

Parents are Responsible for Transportation

Please drop off your child in the car rider lane promptly between 7:30-7:35 a.m. Unfortunately, supervision is not available for siblings or friends of club members. We expect all students to be dropped off no later than 7:35 a.m. There will be no one to let your child in after this time as the club will begin promptly at 7:35 a.m.
