We are working with the Atlanta Track Club's Kilometer Kids Program to offer a running club to 5<sup>th</sup> graders this fall. All registration forms are due to Coach Robertson no later than September 5, 2019. The first 40 participants signed up will be accepted.

### **Practices:**

The Running Club will meet every Monday and Thursday on the following dates from 3:20-4:20 PM:

- September 9, 12, 16, 19, 23, 30
- **\*\*September 26\*\***: Tribble Mill 1 Mile Fun Run (Please see the back of this form for details)
  - **Parents must provide transportation to and from this event. Students will NOT stay after school at Britt.**
- October 3, 7, 17, 21, 28, 31 (No practice October 10, 14, and 24 due to Fall Break and Early Release)
- November 4, 7, 11, 14, 18, 21

Practices will be held outside on the Britt Elementary track/field and/or in the gym. Participants should bring their own water bottle and be dressed for running in appropriate clothes and tennis shoes.

### **The Following are Expectations for all Club Members:**

-Exemplary Behavior during the school day and during club meetings

-Prompt Arrival and Dismissal

-Mandatory Attendance

-During club sessions, members are expected to give their best effort, work as a team, have a positive attitude, and hold up the highest standards of behavior.

### **Attendance Expectations:**

Club members are expected to attend EVERY meeting. A club member may bring a note from a parent the day following a missed meeting (or the first day back from an illness) for an excused absence. A club member may not simply tell me why he or she was absent. They must bring me a note written and signed by a parent. A student may have no more than 2 unexcused absences. Please make a note of this expectation.

### **Parents are Responsible for Transportation**

Please pick up your child at the car rider lane promptly at 4:20 PM. Unfortunately, supervision is not available for brothers, sisters, or friends of club members. Other arrangements will have to be made for them to leave school during the regular dismissal times. We expect all students to be picked up no later than 4:30 PM. The second late pick up will result in removal from the running club. Please make a note of this expectation.

*Since this is a 5<sup>th</sup> grade club, we expect students to know who is picking them up after every practice. If there is someone who is **NOT** allowed to pick up your child, please let us know. Otherwise, we will assume they are getting in the car with the correct person each day.*

**\*\*In the event that any of the expectations are not met, Coach Robertson has the authority to determine whether a student is able to return to the running club.**
