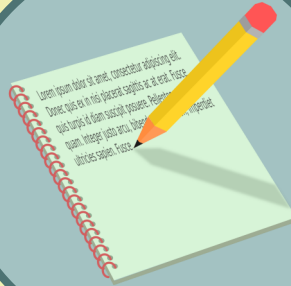


DIGITAL LEARNING

Parent Guide



- ◆ Reinforce the teachers digital expectations
- ◆ Provide a distraction-free work space (free of siblings, chatter, competing electronic devices, toys and pets)
- ◆ Understand the digital platform and its features
- ◆ Ensure your child has materials prepared and readily available
- ◆ Verify that your child is dressed appropriately for school.
- ◆ Create a system that helps your child get to meetings on time (i.e. post a schedule, set alarms)



- ◆ Have your student's GCPS ID number posted by their device.
- ◆ Before classes begin, practice accessing the student portal, E-Class, and Zoom.
- ◆ Provide a distraction free work space for your child.
- ◆ Have materials and supplies prepared and at the work space before the school day begins.
- ◆ Set a student schedule and reinforce meet times.
- ◆ Monitor assignments, due dates, and completed work.
- ◆ Review assignment feedback
- ◆ Allow your child to complete their work independently



- ◆ Check emails daily
- ◆ Communicate concerns to the teacher
- ◆ Use the communication processes that your child's teacher has Implemented (such as the discussion board, emails, and office hours)
- ◆ Confirm that your contact information remains current in the parent portal
- ◆ Understand that emails and phone calls will be returned within 48 hours
