



7th Grade Immunization Requirements

As of July 1, 2014, all students born on or after January 1, 2002 who are entering the 7th grade must have a valid Form 3231 which meets the following new requirements:

1. One dose of Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) vaccine
2. One dose of meningococcal conjugate (MCV) vaccine
