

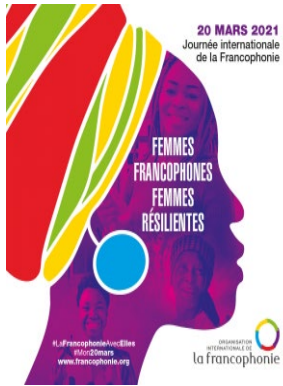

## Car Riders

We have been experiencing a large volume of vehicles arriving at 8:00am or later, causing traffic congestion, parent frustration and tardy students.

Teachers open the car rider doors at **7:35am** and begin accepting students into the building. The doors must close at **8:10am** for teachers to get to class and begin instruction. Typically, from 7:40-8:00am parents will pull up right at the sidewalk and not have to wait at all.



Please abide by the car rider agreement signed when you purchased a car rider tag.

- Follow the traffic pattern and remain in your vehicle.
- Keep children safely in your vehicle until you are parallel to the sidewalk where they may exit the car on the sidewalk and enter the building. **This is a serious SAFETY issue.** Parking and walking students through the parking lot is NOT permitted.

- Drive slowly in all lanes and parking lots surrounding our school. The lives of our students and staff depend on it.
- Students should not exit your vehicle unless a staff member is present. Do not leave students on the sidewalk unattended.
