Graduate Gwinnett

Students who are enrolled in Graduate Gwinnett program will complete their courses one at a time over a period of 20 days per course. Content is delivered online, with built in face-to-face support at the GOC campus. Students are required to attend a one hour face-to-face orientation and complete all state and local testing on campus.



Who qualifies:

- Students at least 16 years old
- Students with at least 18 credits - towards graduation requirements
- Students residing in Gwinnett County

Questions to Consider

Q: What if I am currently a Gwinnett County Public School (GCPS) student?

A: Current GCPS students are not eligible for Graduate Gwinnett. If you are a current student interested in Graduate Gwinnett, you will need to withdraw from your current school and enroll with Gwinnett Online Campus.

Q: Can I take more than one course at a time to graduate even sooner?

A: After successfully completing one course, you will work with the Graduate Gwinnett coordinators to determine your best course plan.

Q: What equipment or supplies will I need?

A: Because the content is online, you will need access to a computer and a reliable internet connection.

Q: Will I still be able to attend college?

A: Yes, the diploma you receive through the Graduate Gwinnett program is issued by Gwinnett County Public Schools.

Q: What if I can't come to campus because I have a job or a child?

A: The majority of the coursework is completed online and is flexible to your needs.
