

AP EXAM INFORMATION

What to bring to the exam:

1. Several sharpened No. 2 pencils with erasers
2. Pens with black or dark blue ink
3. Your six digit school code **111846**
4. A watch
5. A calculator if you are taking the AP Calculus, Chemistry, Physics, or Statistics Exam. Students may bring up to two graphing calculators.
6. A ruler or straightedge if you are taking the AP Physics Exam
7. A Photo ID- Driver's License or School ID
8. Your social security number (optional)
9. Your SSD Student Accommodation Letter, which verifies that you have been approved for extended time or another testing accommodation.

What not to bring to the exam:

1. Cell phones, PDA's, BlackBerry smart phones, Bluetooth- enabled devices, MP3 players, email/messaging devices, and any other electronic or communication devices
2. Books, mechanical pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters **, colored pencils**, compasses
3. Scratch paper/notes
4. Watches that beep or have an alarm
5. Portable listening** or recording devices
6. Computer**
7. Clothing with subject related info
8. Food or drink**

** Unless this has been preapproved as an accommodation by the College Board Services for Students with Disabilities office prior to the exam date.

Late Fee: Students will not get a refund for a test that they do not show up to take. If a student does not show up to take the exam, the student will be charged \$13 for the return fee per exam.

Electronic Devices: Cell phones, PDA's, BlackBerry smart phones, Bluetooth- enabled devices, MP3 players, email/messaging devices, and any other electronic or communication devices are prohibited in the exam room.

Behavior: If you engage in misconduct in connection with the AP exam, you may be asked to leave the testing room and your AP exam will not be graded.

Labeling your AP exam: You will be given an AP student pack the day of the exam. Your bar code labels will be in the middle of the packet. **Remember to bring those labels to each exam.** You will not be given another AP packet.
