

Student Dress Code

- For the 2022-23 school year, students may wear a mask while in the building or waiting to come into the building. No bandanas or ski masks allowed. Please note that mask wearing is strongly encouraged, but not mandatory (policy is subject to change).
- Students must wear appropriate fitting, uniform-style khaki-colored pants. All pockets must be able to be turned inside out for search. Sagging is not permitted.
- Students must wear GIVE Center East, Squad designated T-Shirt at all times while on campus. The shirt may be either long or short sleeved. If an undershirt is worn, it must be solid white or black.
- No hoodies are allowed.
- Solid black, grey, tan, or white jackets/sweatshirts only. Lining must be neutral color (black, white, gray, and tan).
- Shoes must be solid black, solid white, or black and white. Flip flops, sandals, house shoes or slippers are not permitted. Socks must be school appropriate.
- At no time should students' underwear be visible. No shorts/pants under GIVE pants.
- Headbands/hair ties must be solid black/white and may be no wider than 1 inch. They must be worn in the hair. No other hair accessories are allowed.
- No combs/picks/hairbrushes.
- Solid black/white knit hats may be worn outside only.
- Only school issued lanyards may be worn. Keys must be on a single ring and kept in pocket.
- Solid black/white binders only (No pictures/no pockets/no drawings on binder covers).
- A small black, tan, clear, or white purse is allowed.
- Students may not have more than \$20 dollars in their possession.
- Students can only use standard pencils. No mechanical pencils.
- No cell phones/or other electronic devices (i.e. smart watches, AirPods, Bluetooth enabled devices, etc.)
- Only sealed bottled water (at search) is permitted.
- No extra clothing for after school activities (unless written permission provided by GIVE Center East)
- *Any item that is deemed to be a significant distraction or cause a safety concern is at the discretion of the administration team.*

Prohibited items will be collected and released to parents.
