



Welcome to GOC Center at GIVE Center East

Please note that this form of online learning offers the least amount of student support and hands-on learning available at GIVE East. Successful students are disciplined, motivated and independent learners. Students must also have access to a computer and internet service. It is highly unlikely students will be successful when using a phone or tablet to complete coursework. Online students are required to come to the GIVE East campus for orientation. This orientation could last up to 5 days. Before attending orientation, students should log on to the Gwinnett Online Campus website (<https://www.gcpsk12.org/gwinnettonline>) and attempt to sign in using their student ID as both the username and password. Students will need to be able to sign in prior to attending orientation so that they can access their courses during orientation. Please note that it may take 24 hours after registration to access courses. Please contact one of the GOC facilitators if access is not available after 24 hours. Please note that students must be in dress code for orientation as well as any other time they are on campus.

We require online only students to log in daily and complete the assignments that are due. Pacing guides are provided for each course. We suggest that students print the pacing guides and highlight assignments as they are completed. If a student fails to complete daily work within the pacing guidelines, parents will be notified and students will be asked to come on campus. Failure to report to GOC Center at GIVE East will result in the student being marked absent. After 10 absences the GIVE East administrative team will review student progress, attendance, and compliance with the GOC Center online contract. Students may be withdrawn from the GOC Center online only option for lack of progress.

Parents/Guardians/Students: To check real-time grades, log into the GOC site and access each course. At the top of the page, click on "Interaction" and then go to "Class Progress". Here you will be able to view the grade, assignments that have been submitted and are awaiting to be graded, how many times a student has logged into the course, and other useful information.

Gwinnett Online Campus (GOC) Reassessment Policy

1. Reassessments will be offered on 3 dates.
2. Students must notify teachers that they wish to take a reassessment.
3. Students must complete any interventions assigned by the teachers by the due date.
4. Students will report to GIVE East, in uniform, on the date of the reassessment.

Gwinnett Online Campus (GOC) Final Exam Policy

Students will be notified via email and/or phone call when they need to come on campus for testing. In order to maintain the integrity of online learning at GOC, the following 25-point policy applies:

1. If a student's final exam grade is twenty-five (25) or more percentage points lower than his/her test average for the semester, Gwinnett Online Campus may require the student to take a second chance cumulative assessment in a proctored setting to ensure the student's mastery of the course material.
2. The grade on this second chance cumulative assessment must fall within twenty-five (25) percentage points of the student's original test average.
3. If the student's score is twenty-five (25) percentage points lower than the original test average, then the second chance cumulative assessment grade will replace all summative assessment grades.
