On Monday, September 14, 2020, our school will begin utilizing the concurrent classroom model of instruction for all students. We want to share with you the updates in scheduling we have made to ensure we are able to maximize instruction for those who will be attending in-person and those remaining digital.

The concurrent classroom model means that teachers will deliver live (synchronous) instruction for both settings: in-person and digital. Live instruction will occur all day for all students, regardless of setting. This model gives the students who are learning digitally an opportunity to interact with the peers who are receiving in-person instruction. All students will have opportunities to work independently and in small groups.

Students in the digital environment are expected to be present in the Zoom session for a traditional school day. The instructional hours are 8:15am – 2:40pm. Please make sure your student is dressed, prepared and ready for school during these hours. Please make sure your child is in an area free from distractions and is able to focus on their learning. Students learn best when seated at a table or desk in an area free from background noise. Students should be monitored frequently by an adult to ensure they are actively engaged in digital learning. If you would like to consider switching your student from digital learning to in-person learning, please contact your child's teacher or grade level administrator.

We would like to give you additional information while also giving you an opportunity to ask questions. In order to share this information, we will hold a digital Curriculum Night on Thursday, September 24, 2020 at 6:00pm. More information about Curriculum Night will be shared by your child's teacher soon.

We continue to be a collaborative school and our teachers will continue to support each other and deliver instruction that best supports the needs of individual learners.
