Long-term goals were addressed and how we are going to test students this year (Reading and Math as well as Sci and SS). Expectation is both quality growth and quality achievement.		
	COVID-19	Mitch	8:35 - 8:40	59% of students are learning virtually 41% in-person student learning Cafe seating is every other seat for the students and only on one side of the table. As children walk in the hallway, it is every "two squares and then you - two then you" spacing while walking.. Temperatures are taken for all visitors and students who enter the school building. As of now, there is no transmission with Covid in the building. Message to the students is "Wear your mask, wash your hands, and watch your distance." Cleaning is always a must after children go to Discovery classes or rotate classes. Mr. Green explained the traditional model of teaching (virtual and in person). The traditional model works a bit better than having the teachers teaching virtually and in-person at the same time (concurrent model)
