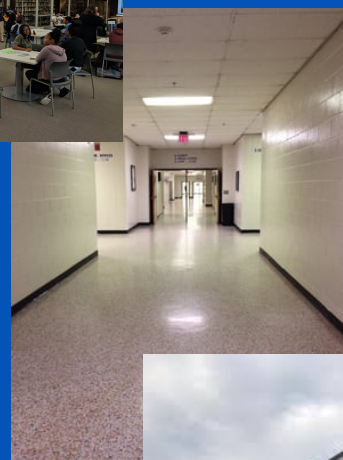


Meadowcreek's Protective Health Measures to Keep Everyone Safe

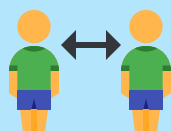
Welcome back Mustangs! This poster provides guidance of how Meadowcreek will ensure the health and safety of the entire school community.



School buses will be unloading at 6:30 am and dismissing at 2:00 pm in zones to eliminate overcrowding.



A face mask is required when entering the building.



Students will transition from class-to-class in hallways and stairwells six feet apart traveling in one direction.



Students will report to their first class immediately after receiving their grab & go breakfast. All students must bring their school IDs for breakfast & lunch. IDs and lanyards will be distributed on the first day back to school.



There are one way signs in most hallways and stairwells.



Transition time between classes has been extended.



Students will be given a designated lunch area with a seating arrangement of six feet apart.



Students should bring their own technology to school EVERYDAY. Also, students can bring a water bottle & snack. Water fountains & vending machines are not in use at this time.



Families are encouraged to monitor students for symptoms, such as a fever, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, body ache, headache, loss of smell or taste, congestion, running nose, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea. If your child has any of these symptoms, please keep them home and contact the school to report the absence.
