FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do Credit Recovery (CR) courses replace the course that I failed?

Successfully completed CR grades will appear on a student's transcript, but they will NOT replace the failed course/grade. Instead, they will be added to the transcript and a "CR" designation will accompany the course title.

I'm an athlete. Should I take Credit Recovery courses?

Credit Recovery courses are NOT recognized by the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) for eligibility purposes. For this reason, prospective college athletes should NOT take Credit Recovery courses.

At which level are Credit Recovery courses taught?

Credit Recovery courses are offered at the standard, college preparatory class level. Resource, Co-Taught, Honors, Gifted, Accelerated, and Advanced Placement courses are not available.

Are accommodations provided?

Special Education and 504 accommodations are NOT supported by the Credit Recovery program.

If I don't finish my Credit Recovery course over the summer, can I finish it during the school year?

Students who do not finish their CR course during the summer will have to register and pay for another session in order to complete it.
