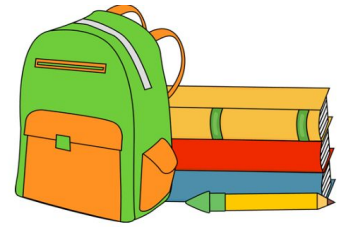




# Literacy Information B.B. Harris Elementary 2020 - 2021

## Some Helpful Tips

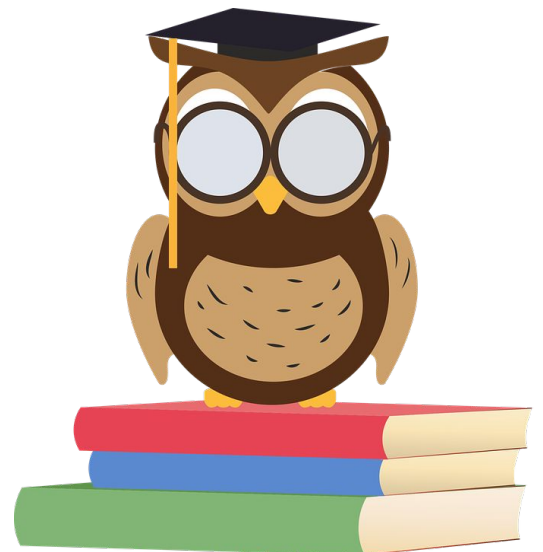
**When engaged in digital learning, find a quiet place to do your work.**
