Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Beaver Ridge Elementary will demonstrate effective reading comprehension skills and fluency on/or above their expected levels of performance/growth on the Gwinnett County Public Schools (GCPS) District Assessments.

- o **Annual Goal**

During the 2020-2021 school year, Beaver Ridge Elementary students in grades 1-5 will demonstrate effective reading comprehension on district assessments with the Reading Unit Assessments indicator:

- Grade 1 will achieve 44% proficient/distinguished
- Grade 2 will achieve 55% proficient/distinguished
- Grade 3 will achieve 55% proficient/distinguished
- Grade 4 will achieve 44% proficient/distinguished
- Grade 5 will achieve 24% proficient/distinguished

During the 2020-2021 school year, Beaver Ridge Elementary Kindergarten students will demonstrate 78% effective literacy skills on the Georgia Kindergarten Inventory of Developing Skills End of Year (EOY).

- **Long Term Goal**

Beaver Ridge Elementary will show proficiency in mathematical computation skills and problem solving abilities on/or above their expected levels of performance/growth on the Gwinnett County Public Schools (GCPS) District Assessments.

- o **Annual Goal**

During the 2020-2021 school year, Beaver Ridge Elementary students in grades 1-5 will show proficiency in mathematical computation skills and problem solving abilities on math unit assessments with the following end-of-year (EOY) indicator:

- Grade 1 will achieve 56% proficient/distinguished
- Grade 2 will achieve 84% proficient/distinguished
- Grade 3 will achieve 62% proficient/distinguished
- Grade 4 will achieve 64% proficient/distinguished
- Grade 5 will achieve 70% proficient/distinguished

During the 2020-2021 school year, Beaver Ridge Elementary Kindergarten students will demonstrate 85% effective mathematics skills on the Georgia Kindergarten Inventory of Developing Skills End of Year (EOY).

- **Long Term Goal**

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in The Plan/The Promise.
