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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. • Long Term Goal

Grayson High School will improve student literacy achievement as measured by an increase in the percentage of students performing in the exceeds range on the Gateway High School Assessment. By 2020-2021, students exceeding the standards in Science and Social Studies will be 31% and 38%, respectively.

o Annual Goal

Grayson High School will increase the percentage of students performing in the exceeds range on the Science Gateway High School Assessment. Science will increase to 31% in 2020-2021. The percentage of students performing in the exceeds range on the Social Studies Gateway High School Assessment will be greater than 38% in 2020-2021.

• Long Term Goal

Grayson High School will increase its graduation rate to 96% in 2020-2021.

Grayson High School will increase its graduation rate to 96% in 2020-2021.

Grayson High School will increase Advanced Placement course enrollment and test participation by 2% for the 2020-2021 school year.

o Annual Goal

Grayson High School will increase its academic performance by meeting and exceeding core academic annual targets as measured by the CCRPI. Particular emphasis will be placed on increasing the academic performance of Students with Disabilities (SWD), English Learner (EL), and all demographic/socioeconomic subgroups. This will be measured by Progress performance in End of Course content area assessments.

o Annual Goal

Grayson Technical School will implement a School Based Enterprise (SBE) and/or Internship Program with a participation rate of 100% for all eligible programs.
