## Local School Plan for Improvement

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in the Family and Community Engagement Plan.

- **Long Term Goal**

The percentage of Meadowcreek students scoring in the Proficient and/or Distinguished levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment (GMAS) in all subject areas will be 100%. Our students will leave Meadowcreek Elementary with the knowledge and skills necessary to be successful in middle school and be able to pursue the college and career of their choice.

- o **Annual Goal**

Meadowcreek Elementary students will demonstrate effective reading comprehension skills by scoring on or above expected levels of performance on GCPS Unit Assessments. All students will score a 70% or above on ELA Unit Assessments.

- o **Annual Goal**

The percentage of Meadowcreek ES students in grades 3-5 performing in the proficient and distinguished range on Georgia Milestones Assessment will increase above the 2018-19 results. The grade level increases are as follows: 3rd Grade ELA: 15% 3rd Grade MA: 15% 4th Grade ELA: 17% 4th Grade MA: 15% 5th Grade ELA: 21% 5th Grade MA: 21% 5th Grade SC: 25% 5th Grade SS: 15%

- o **Annual Goal**

75% of English Learners at Meadowcreek ES will move up at least one performance band as measured by 2020 ACCESS.

- o **Annual Goal**

Meadowcreek Elementary students will demonstrate proficiency in mathematical computation skills and problem solving abilities by scoring on or above their expected levels of performance on the GCPS Unit Assessments. All students will score a 70% or above on Math Unit Assessments.

- **Long Term Goal**

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in The Plan/The Promise.
