Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. • Long Term Goal

All students in grades 3, 4, and 5 will demonstrate proficiency on the Georgia Milestones Assessment in the area of English/Language Arts. Additionally, 40% of all students will demonstrate proficiency at the distinguished level by the year 2021.

o Annual Goal

Students at Mountain Park Elementary in grades 3, 4, and 5 will increase their proficient and/or distinguished grade level percentages, as measured by the Georgia Milestones Assessment in English Language Arts.

Students in grade 3 will increase their percentage to 63.7%.

Students in grade 4 will increase their percentage to 65.5%.

Students in grade 5 will increase their percentage to 67.1%.

Additionally, students at Mountain Park Elementary in grades 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 will increase their proficient and/or distinguished grade level percentages by 5% as measured by the previous administration of the Language Arts Post Assessment compared to the 2020-21 Language Arts Post Assessment.

Students in grade 1 will increase their percentage from 55% to 60%.

Students in grade 2 will increase their percentage from 48% to 53%.

Students in grade 3 will increase their percentage from 60% to 65%.

Students in grade 4 will increase their percentage from 52% to 57%.

Students in grade 5 will increase their percentage from 27% to 32%.

o Annual Goal

Students at Mountain Park Elementary in grade 5 will increase their proficient and/or distinguished grade level percentages, as measured by the Georgia Milestones Assessment in Science.

Students in grade 5 will increase their percentage to 69.9%.

Additionally, students at Mountain Park Elementary in grades 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 will increase their proficient and/or distinguished grade level percentages by 5% as measured by the previous administration of the Science Post Assessment compared to the 2020-21 Science Post Assessment.

Students in grade 3 will increase their percentage from 47% to 52%.

Students in grade 4 will increase their percentage from 48% to 53%.

Students in grade 5 will increase their percentage from 81% to 86%.



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o Annual Goal

Students at Mountain Park Elementary in grade 5 will increase their proficient and/or distinguished grade level percentages, as measured by the Georgia Milestones Assessment in Social Studies.

Students in grade 5 will increase their percentage to 58.4%.

Additionally, students at Mountain Park Elementary in grades 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 will increase their proficient and/or distinguished grade level percentages by 5% as measured by the previous administration of the Social Studies Post Assessment compared to the 2020-21 Social Studies Post Assessment

Students in grade 3 will increase their percentage from 35% to 40%.

Students in grade 4 will increase their percentage from 31% to 36%.

Students in grade 5 will increase their percentage from 44% to 49%.

• Long Term Goal

All students in grades 3, 4, and 5 will demonstrate proficiency on the Georgia Milestones Assessment in the area of Math. Additionally, 40% of all students will demonstrate proficiency at the distinguished level by the year 2021.

o Annual Goal

Students at Mountain Park Elementary in grades 3, 4, and 5 will increase their proficient and/or distinguished grade level percentages, as measured by the Georgia Milestones Assessment in Mathematics.

Students in grade 3 will increase their percentage to 75.7%.

Students in grade 4 will increase their percentage to 73.4%.

Students in grade 5 will increase their percentage to 67.4%.

Additionally, students at Mountain Park Elementary in grades 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 will increase their proficient and/or distinguished grade level percentages by 5% as measured by the previous administration of the Mathematics Post Assessment compared to the 2020-21 Mathematics Post Assessment.

Students in grade 1 will increase their percentage from 94% to 99%.

Students in grade 2 will increase their percentage from 82% to 87%.

Students in grade 3 will increase their percentage from 64% to 69%.

Students in grade 4 will increase their percentage from 44% to 49%.

Students in grade 5 will increase their percentage from 61% to 66%.
