Local School Plan for Improvement

Shiloh High School

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Shiloh High School will increase its graduation rate to 88% in 2024-2025.

- o **Annual Goal**

Shiloh High School will increase its graduation rate to 80% in 2020-21.

- **Long Term Goal**

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in The Plan/The Promise.

- **Long Term Goal**

Shiloh High School's passing rate for first-time testers on the Gateway Social Studies and Science will increase to 80% or higher by 2024-2025.

- o **Annual Goal**

The percentage of students succeeding on internal, practice Gateway Exams will increase in the meets and exceeds level from 64% to 72% in Social Studies and from 59% to 70% in Science.

- **Long Term Goal**

Shiloh High School will increase the percentage of students performing at proficient or above on all End of Course assessments, District Assessments and/or SPG's and End of Pathway Assessments by 25% or higher as well as state and national assessments by 2024-2025.

- o **Annual Goal**

Shiloh High School will improve student achievement by meeting or exceeding the district average on End of Course (EOC) Assessments. This will be formatively monitored by performance on Common Unit Assessments.

- **Long Term Goal**

Shiloh High School will improve its overall CCRPI goal to 80% by 2024-2025.

- **Long Term Goal**

Shiloh High School will improve participation and performance in its accelerated programs with an increase of 25% in enrollment and 20% in student performance by 2024-2025.

- o **Annual Goal**

Shiloh High School will improve participation and performance in its accelerated programs with an increase of 5% in enrollment and 5% in student performance.

- **Long Term Goal**

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in the Parent Involvement Policy and School/Parent Compact.
