Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. • Long Term Goal

The percentage of Stripling Elementary School students in grades 3, 4, and 5 achieving in the Proficient/Distinguished range on the Mathematics and Language Arts sections of the Georgia Milestones State Assessment will continue to increase annually to 60% and by 2022-2023.

o Annual Goal

Stripling ES students will demonstrate effective reading comprehension skills and fluency by scoring on or above expected levels of performance/growth on Gwinnett County Public Schools' (GCPS) Unit Assessments.

All students will score a 70% or above on ELA Unit Assessments.

o Annual Goal

Stripling ES students will demonstrate proficiency in mathematical computation skills and problem solving abilities by scoring on or above their expected levels of performance/growth on the Gwinnett County Public Schools District (GCPS) Unit Assessments.

All students will score a 70% or above on Math Unit Assessments.

o Annual Goal

Stripling Elementary school will increase the engagement of stakeholders as measured by an increase in the mean score on the Q12 specifically focused on questions related to the areas of engagement.

Q02. I have the materials and equipment I need to do my work right.

Q03. At work, I have the opportunity to do what I do best every day.
