Parents, I encourage you to get involved in your children's education by asking them questions about their school experience. When asking questions you will want to ask open-ended questions where students will share more than just yes or no. "How was your day at school?" limits children to "good" "fine" "ok" as their answers. Ask questions like what book is your teacher reading to you? Show me an example of the math you learned today. In Science, what was your learning target? Questions like these offer students the chance to explain the learning process.

Also, sit down at the computer together and have your child log in to their My eCLASS Student Portal. The student portal gives students access to a selection of grade-specific digital textbooks and resources, the online research library, a media catalog, eBooks, and much much more...all with a single sign-on!

PBIS is a team based school-wide design for discipline which includes all students and all staff in all settings. It is a framework that can be modified as we go along to better meet the needs of our student population by using the results of surveys completed by students, parents, and staff and the analysis of discipline data.
