FUNDRAISING

Taste of Mill Creek was canceled for numerous reasons but we do still need to raise funds for the program. We are going to utilize the following fundraising programs for 2021:

Tidal Wave Car Wash Voucher Program: Every player will be required to sell 20 vouchers. You will pay for 20 vouchers at \$10/ea. when you pick them up. You will then sell those vouchers and recoup your \$200. ANY player has the option to pick up their vouchers during one of two selling periods. The first opportunity is mid-November. If you choose to sell them during the first selling period, you can pick up your tickets:

Friday, November 13th at 5-6pm – front of school for drive-thru pick up

Sunday, November 15th at 10-11am – front of school for drive thru pick up

Payment is due at time of pick up. Cash or Checks (made payable to MCHS Goal Club,) PayPal (millcreeksoccer@gmail.com) payments prior to pick up using "SENDING TO A FRIEND" or VENMO (@hawkssoccer) payment prior to pick up. For any player who makes the roster in January and has not sold their vouchers, the \$200 will be added to your dues statement in January and your tickets will be distributed at the player/parents meeting.

Ad/Banner Sales: This program is ongoing each year. Updated forms are available on the Mill Creek Soccer page (link above) and include: sales form, sales information and detailed listing of which sponsors are accounted for by current players. Completed forms with payment can be mailed to: Mill Creek Goal Club, 1543 Autumn Sage Drive, Dacula GA 30019. You can begin selling ads and banners at any time.

Kroger Card Link: Please go to Kroger.com and link your Kroger account to Mill Creek Soccer. This amount can really add up with continued participation. It only takes a few minutes but can mean more funding for our program. Instructions:

Spring Break Fundraiser Raffle: Any player attending the Rocky Mountain Cup will be required to sell 10 raffle tickets at \$10 each. Specific raffle details will be outlined when the tickets are distributed.

*Please note that if you sell car wash vouchers, ads or banners and do not make the roster, you will not be reimbursed for your sales. You may specify that the funds be transferred to another player or they will be used toward team programming.
